In addition, the Foundation has been successful in acquiring a scholarship to Staccato Studios in Tulsa for the highest placing contestant that is a Sophomore in high school or younger, as well as a \$1,000 Tuition waiver from Rogers State University to the highest placing Junior or Senior in high school.
